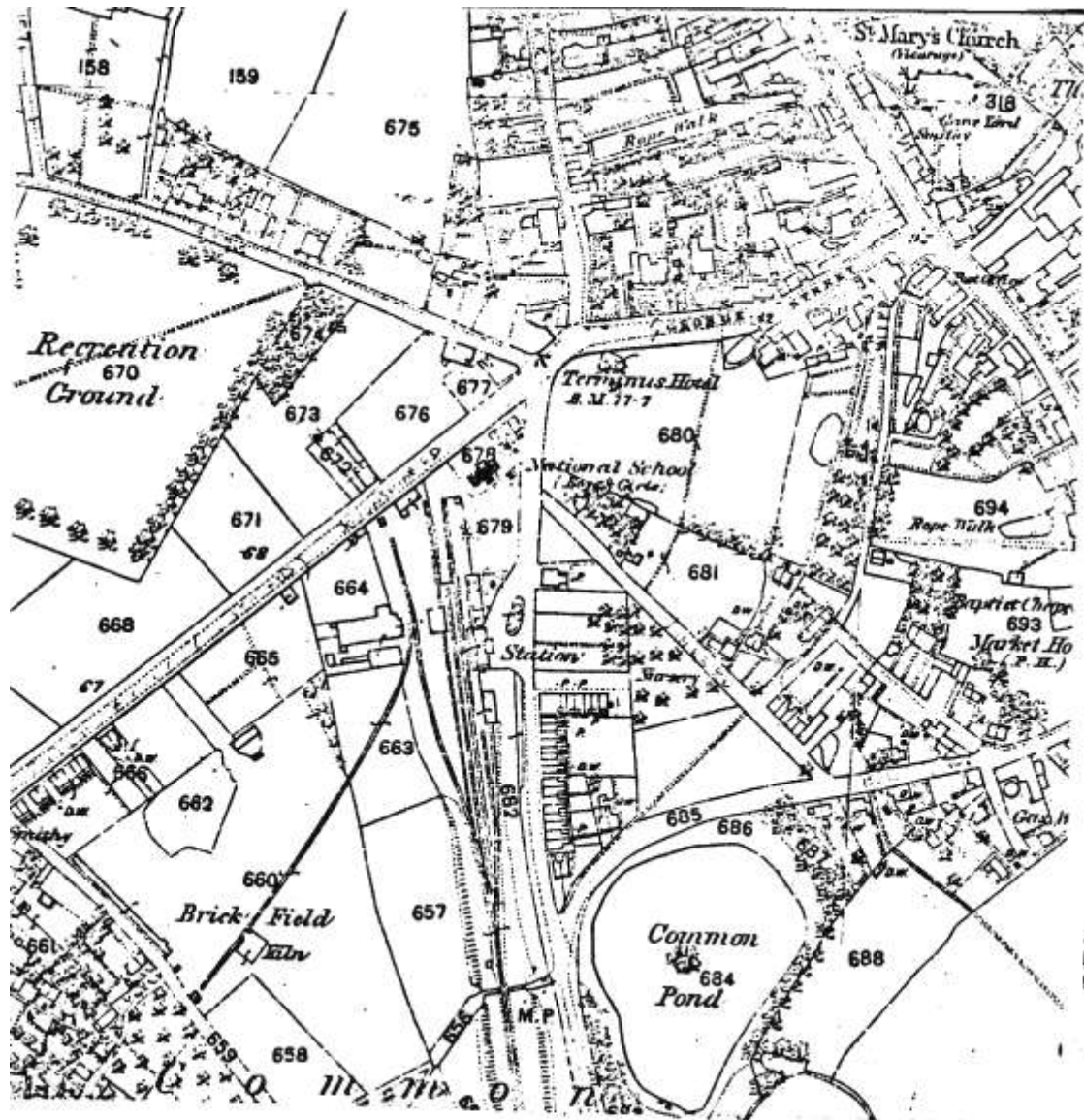


1874 map, Hailsham Station



Reduction of the Ordnance Survey 25 inch map of 1874, showing the railway station before the northern extension. Note the alignment of South Road and Western Road, which was altered when the railway bridge was built.
